

Removal of Stock Exhaust:

- 1. Remove the rear portion of the heat shield that wraps around the clamp joining the head pipe to the muffler (**Figure 1**).
- 2. Loosen the original clamp on the muffler.
- 3. Remove the two bolts (each side) at the bottom of the muffler holding it to the frame.
- 4. Remove the 4 bolts holding the heat shield on top of the muffler (**Figure 2**). This stays in the bike but has to be loose to remove the original muffler.
- 5. Pull the muffler out of the rear of the bike.
- 6. Remove the top left bolt from the hitch mount (**Figure 2**).

Installation of MBRP Exhaust:

- 1. Slide the **Inlet Pipe** into the expanded end of the **Muffler** so that the **Spring** mounts line up on both.
- 2. Install the **Spring**.
- 3. Install the **Clamp** over the new **Inlet Pipe** now.
- 4. With the original metallic gasket removed, slide the **Muffler** in from the rear of the bike until the **Inlet Pipe** slides over the original head pipe. (The new exhaust system does not use the original clamp or the metallic gasket at the slip joint as the **Inlet Pipe** is expanded to go snuggly over the head pipe.)
- 5. The **Muffler** and the **Inlet Pipe** can then be twisted slightly so that no part of the new exhaust touches the frame. Bolt the **Twisted bracket** to the hitch mount. Slide the **Muffler Band** over the muffler and bolt it to the **Twisted bracket**.
- 6. Install the heat shield.
- 7. Install the M8 x 30mm Hex bolt and the M8 x 25mm Hex bolt holding the top heat shield.
